

### TIMELINE OF THE OLD TESTAMENT


Samuel was a Priest, Prophet and Judge.








### SHILOH





### THE SINS OF ELI'S SONS



#### I Samuel 2

"<sup>22</sup>Now Eli was very old, and heard all that his sons did unto all Israel; and how they lay with the women that assembled at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation. <sup>23</sup>And he said unto them, Why do ye such things? for I hear of your evil dealings by all this people. <sup>24</sup>Nay, my sons; for it is no good report that I hear: ye make the LORD'S people to transgress. <sup>25</sup>If one man sin against another, the judge shall judge him: but if a man sin against the LORD, him? shall intreat for who Notwithstanding they hearkened not unto the voice of their father, because the LORD would slay them."






Eli reproved his sons too gently. He didn't threaten them as he should have. He didn't take action to stop their behavior.





#### I Samuel 2

As Samuel grew he showed himself to be faithful, but Eli's sons became more and more profane and evil. They rebelled against the Lord, but Samuel ministered to Him; they ignored their father's admonitions, but Samuel was obedient; they profaned holy things, but Samuel served under Eli's eye and direction.








I Samuel 2 tells about a prophet that went to Eli and asked him why he honored his sons above God, for Eli was not reprimanding his sons. The prophet told Eli that both of his sons would die in one day (Verse 34).








God spoke to Samuel and told him horrible news for Eli.





"15 And Samuel lay until the morning, and opened the doors of the house of the LORD. And Samuel feared to show Eli the vision."








## THE PHILISTINES CAPTURE THE ARK OF THE COVENANT





